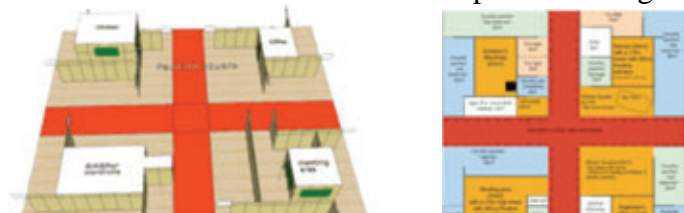
The afternoon will be about policies and funding for organic agriculture and trade. This part of the program will focus on issues that are crucial for donors, governments and development agencies.
